### Shoulder Widening Project Continues on State Route 18

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the safety operation on State Route 18 (SR-18) in and near the city of Adelanto from the United States Highway 395 (US-395) junction to 263<sup>rd</sup> East Street. This project includes the widening of existing shoulders to state standards and the installation of shoulder rumble strips.

Closures will take place Monday through Friday, January 27 through January 31, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. daily. One-way traffic control with flagging will be in effect. Please expect delays during construction hours. Be advised, weather conditions may affect this operation.
