Update 4 Emergency Work Continues on The Milliken Avenue Over-Passing on Interstate 10

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue the emergency bridge repairs on the Milliken Ave. overpassing on Interstate 10 (I-10) in Ontario. The work will begin tonight of Monday, July 1. One lane will always remain open on I-10 in both directions during the work hours. Please view the paragraph below for closure details on east and westbound I-10 and the Milliken Avenue exit. Please be advised, lengthy delays are anticipated during the work hours. If possible, use an alternate route.

On Monday, July 1 the number 1, 2, and 3 lanes on westbound I-10 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. Also, on Monday, July 1 the number 1, 2, and 3 lanes will be closed on eastbound I-10 from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. On Tuesday, July 2 the number 4 and 5 lanes on westbound I-10 from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. will be closed. Also, on Tuesday, July 2 the number 4 and 5 lanes on eastbound I-10 will be closed from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. Finally, on Tuesday, July 2 the westbound Milliken Avenue off-ramp will be closed from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m. and the eastbound on-ramp from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m.
