### Shoulder Widening Continues on US-395 South of Kramer Hills

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue the safety operation south of Kramer Hills on United States Highway 395 (US-395). This project includes a median buffer, widening of shoulders to state standards, and installation of centerline and shoulder rumble strips.

Closures will take place on August 3, 5 and 6 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and August 11 through August 14 from 8:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. One-way traffic control with flagging will be in effect. Please expect delays during construction hours. Be advised, weather conditions may affect this operation.
