Bridge Restriping and Maintenance Work Continues

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue bridge re-striping and maintenance work at various locations on Interstate 210 (I-210), Interstate 10 (I-10), Interstate 15 (I-15), State Route 18 (SR-18), State Route 138 (SR-138) and State Route 395 (SR-395) in San Bernardino County. The night work will start Monday, September 16 at 9 p.m. and is anticipated to be completed November 2019. There will be alternating lane closures on each bridge as the work is being done. One lane in each direction will always remain open. Please view the chart below for closure details.
