State Route 74 Raised Curb Median Construction Activities for Week of September 23, 2019

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on a \$13.1 million safety project to construct a raised curb median with access points and left turn lanes on State Route 74 (SR-74) at various locations from just west of Acacia Avenue to Ramona Expressway.

The contractor, Autobahn Construction, Inc from the City of Orange, will continue perform traffic signal electrical work next week at various locations from Myers Street to New Chicago Avenue. There will also be a survey crew working to prepare for the median installation. The work hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and the #1 lane and right shoulder will be closed in each direction. The project is expected to last approximately one year.
