State Route 243 Pavement Rehabilitation Project

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$8.5 million-dollar pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 243 (SR-243) in Banning. The project has been awarded to Matich Corporation of San Bernardino. The second phase of work is anticipated to start Monday, September 30 within the city limits of Banning from 8th Street, West Lincoln Street and South San Gorgonio Avenue. This phase is anticipated to be finished by Monday, October 7. During this time, construction on 8th Street and West Lincoln Street will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and on South San Gorgonio Avenue from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. There will be a one-way flagging operation during these times. Please remember to reduce your speed and always Be Work Zone Alert.
