State Route 243 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Continues

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$8.5 million-dollar pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 243 (SR-243) in Banning. The project has been awarded to Matich Corporation of San Bernardino. Starting Monday October 7, the pavement rehabilitation work will resume from South San Geronio Avenue to Black Mountain Creek (Postmile 29.7). Work has been scheduled to take place Monday – Friday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and is anticipated to be complete by April 1 of 2020. During this time-frame, there will be a one-way flagging-operation. Please remember to reduce your speed and always Be Work Zone Alert.
