State Route 74 Raised Curb Median Safety Project Set to Begin After Fourth of July

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$13.1 million safety project after the Fourth of July holiday to construct a raised curb median with access points and left turn lanes on State Route 74 (SR-74) at various locations from just west of Acacia Avenue to Ramona Expressway.

The contractor, Autobahn Construction, Inc from the City of Orange, will place construction area signs on Monday, July 1, 2019. On July 8, the contractor will begin potholing and identifying underground utilities at Golden Village, Gilmore Street, Lyon Avenue, Palm Avenue, State Street and Harvard Street. The work hours will be 6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and one lane will remain open in each direction. The project is expected to last approximately one year.
