### Update 1 Emergency Road Repairs Continue on State Route 18

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will start the next phase of emergency drainage, guardrail and slope repairs in “The Narrows” (Post mile 19.6 to 20.6) on State Route 18 (SR-18) in San Bernardino. The work has been postponed and will begin Monday, July 29 and last approximately two months. Traffic will be controlled by a flagging operation Monday through Thursday from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. Please remember to be work zone alert as you approach the area.
