Bridge Preventative Maintenance and Restriping Continues

Riverside – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a \$2.4 million-dollar bridge preventative maintenance and restriping project at various locations on Interstate 10 (I-10), State Route 79 (SR-79) and State Route 86 (SR-86) in Riverside County. The project has been awarded to Velarde Concrete Construction, Inc. of San Fernando, California and is anticipated to be complete December 2020. During this project, a one-way flagging operation will be in place as crews alternate work between lanes on each bridge. Please view the chart below for work details.
